

Assistant City Attorneys may be appointed from time to time by the Council, if deemed necessary. They may also employ special counsel from time to time as it deems necessary after first considering no less than three (3) individuals names submitted for evaluation. At least four (4) members of the council must approve the employment of special counsel to serve a general or specific legal purpose until such time that the nature of the matter or matters is resolved or new special counsel is employed by the Council.

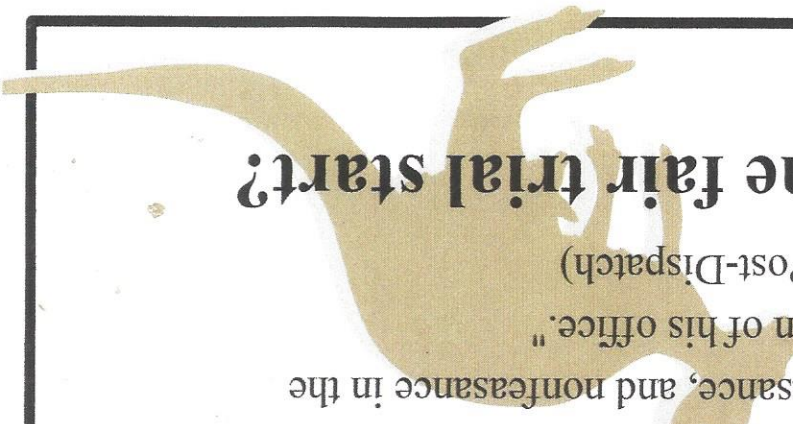

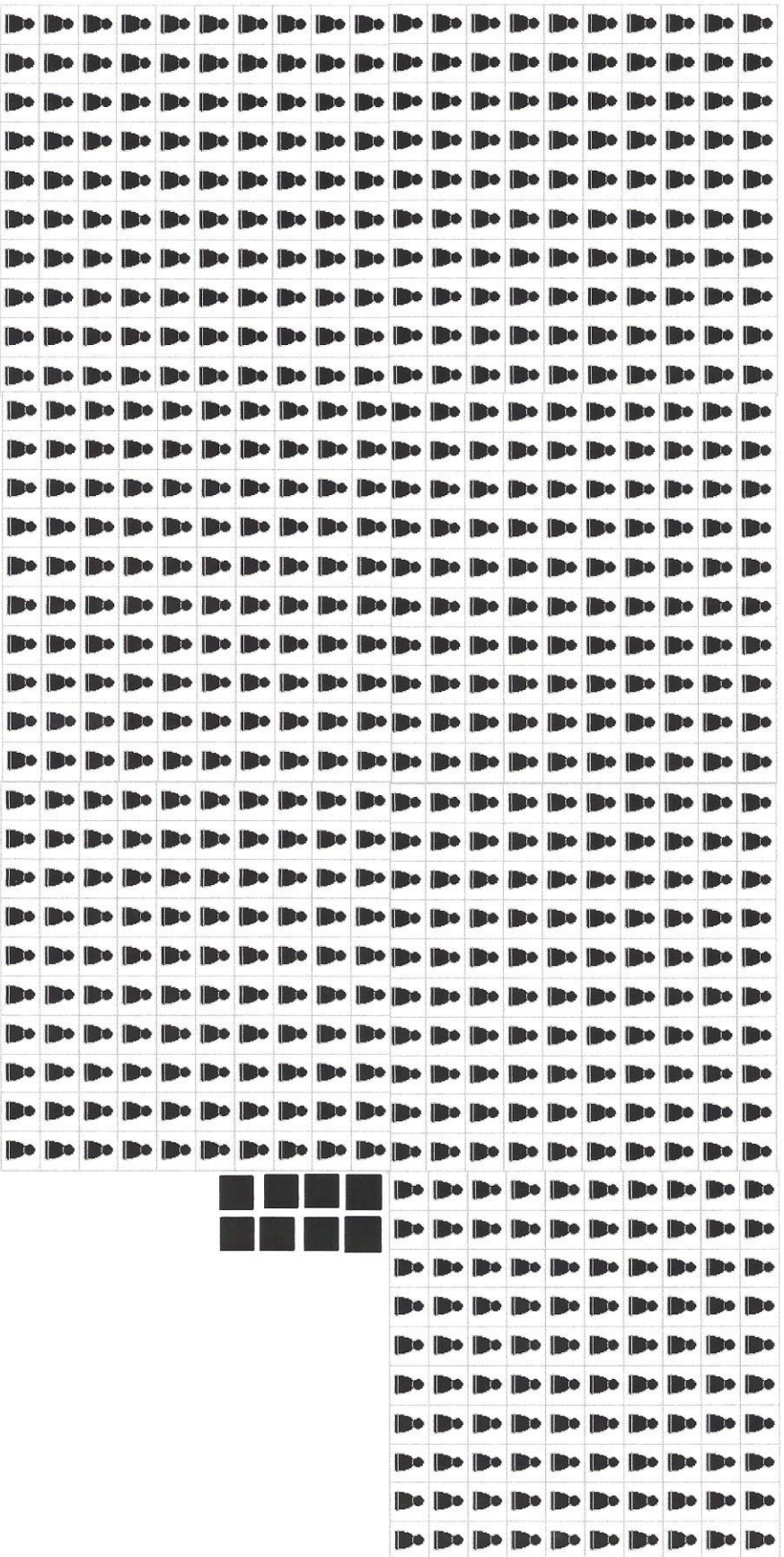

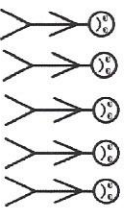
**What day did the fair trial start?**
